

ORDINANCE NO. 09-2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 04-2001 REGARDING  
THE APPLICABLE DATE CONTAINED IN SECTION 1 THEREOF,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council adopted Ordinance No. 04-2001 on March 19, 2001 regarding the adoption of Rider "A" rate schedule applicable to the Village's electric rate schedules; and

WHEREAS, contained in Section 1 of said Ordinance No. 04-2001, there occurred a typographical error regarding the effective date of said Rider "A"; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the correct date to be contained in Section 1 is March 19, 2001 and not March 5, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Council has further determined that this Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 04-2001, be adopted as an emergency measure due to the need to adjust the electric rates to insure responsible revenue to the electric department, and therefore is immediately necessary to protect the public peace, health and safety of the Village, and dictates that this Ordinance should be effective immediately upon its adoption and certification by the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer, respectively; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:


Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 04-2001 be, and hereby is, amended to be as follows:

Section 1. The Rider "A" Power Supply Cost Adjustment Applicable To Village's Electric Rate Schedules, attached to Ordinance No. 08-93, be modified and changed to Rider "A" Power Supply Cost Adjustment Applicable To Village's Electric Rate Schedules dated March 19, 2001, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part hereof.


Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to this Ordinance were taken in meetings of Council, open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 04-2001 is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village of Oak Harbor, Ohio for the reasons set forth in the

preamble and thus, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Oak Harbor, Ohio.

RIDER "A"

POWER SUPPLY COST ADJUSTMENT  
APPLICABLE TO VILLAGE'S ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULES

**APPLICABILITY:** The Power Supply Cost Adjustment set forth herein shall apply to the Village's Electric Rate Schedules that are subject to this Rider "A". The applicable adjustment shall be applied to the total kWh billed to Consumer for the meter reading period that Village determines as most nearly corresponding to the meter reading period(s) set forth in Village's purchased power billings from its supplier(s).

**BASE POWER SUPPLY COSTS:** The rates and charges set forth in Village's Rate Schedules are based on the cost of Village's power requirements as furnished by American Municipal Power-Ohio (AMP-Ohio). The Base Power Supply Cost included in Village's Rate Schedules is \$0.040000 per kWh.

**MONTHLY DETERMINATION OF POWER SUPPLY COST ADJUSTMENT:** Each month Village's Power Supply Cost adjustment shall be determined as follows:

- (a) The Village's Running Twelve Month Average Power Supply Cost per kWh shall be determined to 6 decimal places by dividing (1) the sum of the previous eleven month's and current month's total purchased power billings from all suppliers, including costs associated with ownership and operation of generating facilities owned in whole, or in part, by the Village, wheeling charges and AMP-Ohio Service Fees, by (2) the total energy delivered to Village in the previous eleven month's and the current month.
- (b) The Base Power Supply Cost of \$0.040000 per kWh shall then be subtracted from the Running Twelve Month Average Power Supply Cost determined in (a) above.
- (c) The Power Supply Cost Adjustment per kWh shall be determined by multiplying the differential derived in (b) by 1.10 to compensate for Village's Distribution System Losses. The result should then be rounded out to the nearest 0.10 mill (\$0.0001) per kWh.

The above adjustment shall be applicable to the Security Light Charges, as set forth in Schedule "SL".

Adopted by the Village Council on March 19, 2001.

Effective for all bills payable on or after March 19, 2001.
