

ORDINANCE NO. 10-2001

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SFT, INC. FOR DESIGN AND PREPARATION OF SPECIFICATIONS, SOLICIT BIDS AND AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE CHURCH STREET LIGHTING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Utilities Committee commissioned a feasibility study by the Village's consulting electrical engineer, SFT, of the improvement of street lighting to Church Street within the Village, and said study has been considered by the Committee; and

WHEREAS, based upon said feasibility study, the Utilities Committee and the Village Administrator have determined that it is necessary to install street lighting along Church Street and to install underground duct-work for the street lighting and Apple Festival circuitry; and

WHEREAS, Council, based upon the recommendation of the Utilities Committee, desires to authorize the Village Administrator to prepare specifications, solicit bids for said project, and to award the contract for the Church Street Lighting Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with SFT, INC. for electrical engineering services including design of the project and preparation of specifications for the Church Street Lighting Project, in the estimated amount of \$17,000.00.

Section 2. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby is, directed to advertise for bids for said Church Street Lighting Project consisting of the installation of street lighting along Church Street, and the installation of underground duct-work for the street lighting and Apple Festival circuitry.


Section 3. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby is, directed to award a contract for said Church Street Lighting Project to the lowest and best bidder within ten percent of the engineer's estimate of \$162,000.00.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to this Ordinance were taken in meetings of Council, open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Ordinance authorizing the Village Administrator to prepare specifications, solicit bids and award a contract for the Church Street Lighting Project shall take effect and be in full force and effect and after the earliest date allowed by law.
