

ORDINANCE NO. 19-2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 715 ESTABLISHING  
GENERAL PARK REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Oak Harbor, Ohio, enacted Ordinance No. 715 on June 3, 1980, providing for general park regulations; and

WHEREAS, Section 69.01(B)(3) refers to a "barn commonly used for family and social gatherings", and such "barn" no longer exists; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to amend the Ordinance to remove the reference to said structure; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 715, passed on June 3, 1980, be, and the same hereby is, amended to be as follows:

§ 69.01 GENERAL PARK REGULATIONS

(A) Those areas of the village which have been designated by the Legislative Authority as being for recreational or park purposes shall be defined as parks. Further, any reference to parks in this chapter or in any of the village ordinances, regulations or rules shall mean such areas.

(B) The following are prohibited by any person in the parks of the village:

(1) Placing, throwing, scattering, or distributing refuse, garbage, junk debris, paper or other rubbish.

(2) Mutilating, defacing, destroying, removing, breaking, or tearing any structure, wall, fence, railing, vehicle, plant, shrub, tree, sign or other property.


(3) Using, drinking, or consuming intoxicating liquor or alcoholic beverages.

(4) Driving of vehicles, whether motorized or not, on the tennis courts.


(5) Driving vehicles in excess of 10 miles per hour.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to this Ordinance were taken in meetings of Council, open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 715 shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
