

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO  
SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF  
NATURAL RESOURCES FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLIC  
RECREATION PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Program and/or the State of Ohio Nature Works; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator desires to make an application for financial assistance for the acquisition of property to be utilized for recreational purposes connected with the Riverfront Development Project; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that submitting an application for financial assistance to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources before the deadline of July 1, 2001, as being necessary for the immediate health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village, that this Resolution shall be adopted as an emergency measure to take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer, respectively;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby is, directed to submit an application for financial assistance for the Riverfront Development Project with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Nature Works Program.


Section 2. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby is, directed to execute and file an application and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3. That the Village Administrator be authorized to agree to obligate the funds required to acquire property to be utilized for recreational purposes connected with the Riverfront Development Project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Nature Works Program.


Section 4. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That for the reasons stated in the preamble

hereto, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and authentication by the Mayor and Clerk respectively.
